Exam Information

The Certified Information Security Management Systems – Lead Implementer exam is taken online through Mile2’s Learning Management System and is accessible on your Mile2.com account. The exam will take approximately 2 hours and consist of 100 multiple choice questions.

A minimum grade of 70% is required for certification.

Re-Certification Requirements

All Mile2 certifications will be awarded a 3-year expiration date.

There are two requirements to maintain Mile2 certification:

- 1) Pass the most current version of the exam for your respective existing certification
- 2) Earn and submit 20 CEUs per year in your Mile2 account.
